## Used to

 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• She <b>used to eat</b> meat when she was seven years old</li> </ul>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Now, she is vegetarian</li> </ul>
 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He <b>used to steal</b> when he was younger</li> </ul>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Now, he is in prison</li> </ul>



- They used to go to school



- Now, they are at university

➤ We use the modal verb "used to" to talk about **PAST HABITS**, which means, that now we don't do those habits in the present anymore.

#### FORM: How do we use the modal verb USED TO?

Affirmative +

SUBJECT + USED TO + VERB → I USED TO SWIM

Negative -

SUBJECT + DIDN'T USE TO + VERB → I DIDN'T USE TO SWIM

Interrogative ?

DID + SUBJECT + USE TO + VERB + ? → DID YOU USE TO SWIM?
